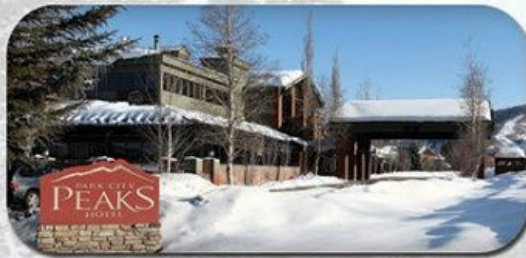

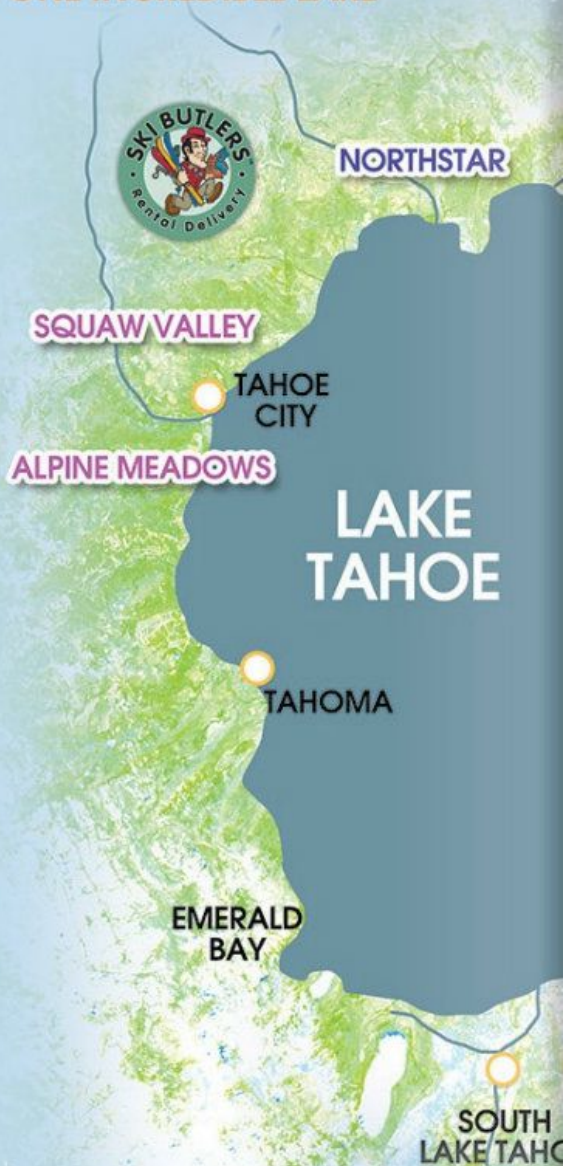

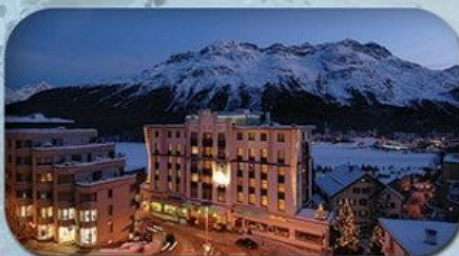

Vallnord in La Massana and Ordino valleys and Grandvalira, in Canillo and Encamp valleys. Naturlandia, in La Rabassa forest in Sant Julià, offers 12 miles of Nordic trails. Vallnord offers over 55 miles of slopes in three sectors: Pal, Arinsal and Arcalis. Encamp, Canillo, El Tarter, Soldeu, Grau Roig and Pas de la Casa are entry points to Grandvalira – the largest skiable area in the Pyrenees with over 124 miles of slopes. Both resorts offer a wide variety of activities for all ages.
